## NOTICE FOR APPLICANT OF HIGHER SURGICAL TRAINEE

---

To enter the Higher Surgical Training Programme of the College of Surgeons of Hong Kong(CSHK), applicants must fulfill the following requirements:

- ✓ One must be fully registered with the Medical Council of Hong Kong
- ✓ One must obtain the Ordinary Membership of the College
- ✓ One must have passed the Conjoint Selection Exercise of Higher Surgical Trainees held by the Hospital Authority of Hong Kong and the College
- ✓ One must obtain a Higher Surgical Training post from an approved training unit/institution in Hong Kong

Please read the followings carefully before registering the Higher Surgical Training with the College.

- 1) Trainees who have passed the Membership Examination of the Hong Kong Intercollegiate Board of Surgical Colleges(MHKICBSC) in Hong Kong and satisfactorily complete the basic surgical training MUST apply for Ordinary Membership of the College of Surgeons of Hong Kong (MCSHK) and *passed Conjoint Selection Exercise Admission to Higher Surgical Training* before they can register as Higher Surgical Trainee of the College. Those who have not registered with the College of Surgeons of Hong Kong or have not been admitted as an Ordinary Member of the College are not allowed to sit for the Fellowship Examination.
- 2) All Higher Surgical Trainees must submit the registration form to the Education & Examination Committee via the Secretariat of CSHK **within the first month** of Higher Surgical Training. **Late submission will render the respective training period NOT recognized.**
- 3) All applicants are required to submit the following documents together with the Higher Surgical Trainee Registration Form in order to complete the application process:

- Curriculum Vitae(C.V.)
- Certified True Copy of other relevant examinations/qualifications(if any)

A crossed cheque of HKD 1,200(Annual Registration Fee) should be made payable to "The College of Surgeons of Hong Kong **Limited**". The cheque will be returned to the applicant by post if the application is unsuccessful.

Higher Surgical Trainees are required to pay their registration fee annually within the first month of the year until they have completed their Higher Surgical Training.

- 4) The appointment to a hospital **must be certified** by the respective supervisor before the respective training period could be recognized and registered.

- 5) A registered trainee will receive a Guide to Surgical Training upon successful registration including the following documents:
- Rules & Regulations for Higher Surgical Trainee
  - Eligibility for Ordinary Membership / Higher Surgical Training / Examination Eligible Candidate / Fellowship / Fellowship Without Examination
  - Mandatory Courses for Higher Surgical Trainee
  - Guidance Notes for Research Requirements
  - Guidelines on Major Operation for Higher Surgical Trainee
  - Index Operation Fulfillment Form(*applicable only to Higher Surgical Trainees in General Surgery*)
  - Principles and Guidelines on Continuing Medical Education(CME) and Continuing Professional Development(CPD)
  - Policy on Annual Subscription
  - Logbook Order Form
  - Update of Personal Information
  - Half-yearly Assessment Documentation
