ELIGIBILITY FOR ORDINARY MEMBERSHIP/ HIGHER SURGICAL TRAINING/ EXAMINATION ELIGIBLE CANDIDATE/ FELLOWSHIP/FELLOWSHIP WITHOUT EXAMINATION

ORDINARY MEMBERSHIP

To be eligible for applying for the Ordinary Membership of the College of Surgeons of Hong Kong (CSHK), applicants must fulfill the following requirements:

1. One must be fully registered with the Medical Council of Hong Kong
2. One must complete two-year Basic Surgical Training of the Hong Kong Intercollegiate Board of Surgical Colleges(HKICBSC) with satisfactory training performance and proper rotations as prescribed in the Basic Surgical Training Curriculum
3. One must have passed the Membership Examination of HKICBSC(MHKICBSC Examination) held in Hong Kong
4. One must have completed satisfactorily all mandatory courses prescribed in the basic training programme
5. One's application must be proposed and seconded by two paid-up College Fellows

All applicants must submit the following documents together with the Application Form in order to complete the application process:

HIGHER SURGICAL TRAINING

To enter Higher Surgical Training Programme of CSHK, applicants must fulfill the following requirements:

1. One must be fully registered with the Medical Council of Hong Kong
2. One must obtain the Ordinary Membership of CSHK
3. One must have passed the Conjoint Selection Exercise of Higher Surgical Trainees held by the Hospital Authority of Hong Kong and CSHK (Please refer to the website of HA: http://www.ha.org.hk/visitor/ha_visitor_index.asp?Content_ID=1237&Dimension=100&Lang=ENG)
4. One must obtain a Higher Surgical Training post from an approved training units/institutions in Hong Kong

- ↻ A crossed cheque of HKD 1,200 (Annual Registration Fee) made payable to "The College of Surgeons of Hong Kong **Limited**".

EXAMINATION ELIGIBLE CANDIDATE

Those who have fulfilled the training requirements including the duration of training, operational requirements and mandatory courses requirements but not yet passed the required examination will fall into the category of Examination Eligible Candidate (EECs). Clinical Attachment Programme (CAP) is a programme to which EECs will be attached for the purpose of maintaining surgical skills until passing the Fellowship Examination.

FELLOWSHIP

To be eligible for applying for the Fellowship of CSHK, applicants must fulfill the following requirements:

1. One must be fully registered with the Medical Council of Hong Kong
2. One must complete 4/5 years of Higher Surgical Training of CSHK stipulated by the respective Specialty Boards with satisfactory training performance and fulfillment of training requirements prescribed in the Higher Surgical Training Programme
3. One must have passed the Joint Specialty Fellowship Examination/ Specialty Fellowship Examination(*for Plastic Surgery only*) held in Hong Kong or Singapore
4. One's application must be proposed and seconded by two paid-up College Fellows

FELLOWSHIP WITHOUT EXAMINATION

2. One's application must be proposed by 5 paid-up fellows
