ELIGIBILITY FOR TAKING THE MEMBERSHIP EXAMINATION OF HONG KONG INTERCOLLEGIATE BOARD OF SURGICAL COLLEGES

MEMBERSHIP EXAM PART 1 and 2

To be eligible for sitting Membership Exam of Hong Kong Intercollegiate Board of Surgical Colleges, applicants must fulfill the following requirements:

1. Having **full registration with the Hong Kong Medical Council** (i.e. either possesses a primary medical qualification from The University of Hong Kong or The Chinese University of Hong Kong as prescribed by HKICBSC, OR pass the Licensing Examination of the Medical Council of Hong Kong.)@;
2. For Basic Surgical Trainees, they should have paid their registration fee of the exam year and those in arrears before being allowed to take the examination.

@ **FOR MAINLAND CHINA APPLICANTS ONLY:** Being trainees from Mainland China training centres accredited by the constituent Colleges of HKICBSC (provided that they undergo such training at the time of or after the relevant accreditation)

All applicants must submit the following certified documents together with the Application Form in order to complete the application process:

- ✓ **Certified True Copy of Qualification**
 - ✧ **Primary medical qualification** from The University of Hong Kong or The Chinese University of Hong Kong (For **Mainland China Applicants**, they should submit Primary medical qualification, which are verified by medical official of Mainland China training centres accredited by the constituent Colleges of HKICBSC); OR
 - ✧ **Examination result of the Licensing Exam of the Medical Council of Hong Kong**, which are verified by medical or university official, OR a public notary, OR solicitor/lawyer, should have an official stamp accompanying the signature
- ✓ **Two** certified recent passport photographs with the official stamp and signature by medical or university official;

- ✓ **A crossed cheque of full payment** made payable to “The College of Surgeons of Hong Kong LIMITED”.

Special Remarks:

** Candidates may enter Part 1 Examination any time after gaining their primary medical qualification. However, they are strongly recommended to be in BST before sitting for the Part 2 Examination.*

*** Copies of letters and certificates will only be accepted if they have been **verified as true copies** by the Consultant or authorised hospital official and stamped with the **hospital stamp**. (The signature (name of verifier should be stated) and hospital stamp must be original)*
