**JOINT INTER COLLEGIATE HIGHER SPECIALIST EXAMINATION
IN UROLOGY**

The format of the examination:

A. Multiple Choice Questions

There will be some 40 questions covering the entire width and scope of Urology.

B. Clinical Problem Solving Test

This will mainly take the form of questions shown on projecting slides. The questions will include x-rays, pathology specimens, biochemical results and comprehensive clinical problems.

C. Oral Examinations

There will be eight oral examinations, conducted in 4 panels each of 20 minutes in duration and covering the following areas of Urology:

1. a) Uro-Oncology 1 (Kidney and Bladder)
b) Uro – Oncology 2 (Prostate, Testis and Penis)
2. a) Paediatric Urology
b) Emergency Urology (including Nephrology and Renal Transplant)
3. a) Calculi and UTI
b) Urological Imaging and Principles of Urological techniques
4. a) Bladder dysfunction and Gynaecological aspects of Urology
b) BPH and Andrology
