

ELIGIBILITY FOR APPLYING FOR THE

JOINT SPECIALTY FELLOWSHIP EXAMINATION IN

NEUROSURGERY

To be eligible for sitting Joint Specialty Fellowship Examination in Neurosurgery, applicants must fulfill the following requirements:

- 1. One must be a Higher Surgical Trainee (HST) <u>registered</u> with the College of Surgeons of Hong Kong.
- 2. One must obtain the Membership of the College of Surgeons of Hong Kong (CSHK).
- 3. One must complete at least **42 months** of Higher Surgical Training in Neurosurgery with satisfactory training performance and fulfillment of training requirements as prescribed in the Higher Surgical Training Curriculum (Rules and Regulations for Higher Surgical Trainee).
- 4. One must complete all the mandatory courses as prescribed in the *Mandatory Courses for HST*.
- 5. One must complete at least two research projects approved by the Research Committee.
- 6. One must not have their training interrupted within 6 months prior to examination (For details of interruption of training, please refer to "INTERRUPTION OF TRAINING" in "Rules & Regulations For Higher Surgical Trainee").
- 7. One must settle their registration fee of the exam year and those in arrears.
- 8. One must complete 2 Procedure-Based Assessments per annum among their first three years of training.
- 9. One must fulfil the presentation/publication requirements (For details of oral presentation/publication requirements, please refer to "ORAL PRESENTATION / PUBLICATION REQUIREMENTS" in "Rules & Regulations for Higher Surgical Trainee").

 - Neuropathology
 - Neuroradiology
 - Neurology
 - (5/theme; 2 sides of A4)

To be eligible for sitting Joint Specialty Fellowship Examination in Paediatric Surgery, applicants must fulfill the following requirements:

- 3. One must complete at least **42 months** of Higher Surgical Training in Paediatric Surgery with satisfactory training performance and fulfillment of training requirements as prescribed in the Higher Surgical Training Curriculum (Rules and Regulations for Higher Surgical Trainee).
- 4. One must complete all the mandatory courses as prescribed in the *Mandatory Courses for HST*.
- 5. One must complete at least two research projects approved by the Research Committee.
- 6. One must not have their training interrupted within 6 months prior to examination (For details of interruption of training, please refer to "INTERRUPTION OF TRAINING" in "Rules & Regulations For Higher Surgical Trainee").

- 3. One must complete at least **42 months** of Higher Surgical Training in Plastic Surgery with satisfactory training performance and fulfillment of training requirements as prescribed in the Higher Surgical Training Curriculum (Rules and Regulations for Higher Surgical Trainee).
- 4. One must complete all the mandatory courses as prescribed in the *Mandatory Courses for HST*.
