(The signature (name of verifier should be stated) and hospital stamp must be original) *All stamps must be in English*.

Late application or incomplete application (including insufficient postage) will not be accepted. No allowance will be made for postal or other delays. Late applications or incomplete applications will be returned to the applicants. Applications with all supporting documents MUST reach the College Secretariat on or before the closing date as stipulated in the examination calendar.
