FOR APPLICANT OF HIGHER SURGICAL TRAINEE

To enter the Higher Surgical Training Programme of the College of Surgeons of Hong Kong(CSHK), applicants must fulfil <u>all</u> the following requirements:

- ✓ <u>Registered</u> with the Medical Council of Hong Kong
- ✓ Being an Ordinary Member of CSHK
- ✓ Passed the Conjoint Selection Exercise of Higher Surgical Trainees held by the Hospital Authority of Hong Kong and the College
- ✓ Obtained a Higher Surgical Training post from an approved training units/institutions in Hong Kong

Please read the followings carefully before registering the Higher Surgical Training with the College.

- 1) Trainees who have passed the Membership Examination of The Hong Kong Intercollegiate Board of Surgical Colleges (MHKICBSC) in Hong Kong and satisfactorily complete the basic surgical training MUST apply for Ordinary Membership of The College of Surgeons of Hong Kong (MCSHK) and *passed Conjoint Selection Exercise Admission to Higher Surgical Training* before they can register as Higher Surgical Trainee of the College. Those who have not registered with the College of Surgeons of Hong Kong or have not been admitted as an Ordinary Member of the College are not allowed to sit for the Fellowship Examination.
- 2) All Higher Surgical Trainees must submit the registration form to the Education & Examination Committee via the Secretariat of CSHK within the first two weeks of Higher Surgical Training. It is the responsibility of the applicant to make sure the application form reaches our office on time. Late application or incomplete application will not be accepted. No allowance will be made for postal or other delays. Late submission will render the respective training period NOT recognized.
- 3) All applicants are required to submit the following documents together with the Higher Surgical Trainee Registration Form in order to complete the application process:
 - Curriculum Vitae(C.V.)
 - **Certified True Copy of** other relevant examinations/qualifications(if any)

<u>A crossed cheque of HKD 2,100</u> (Annual Registration Fee) should be made payable to "The College of Surgeons of Hong Kong <u>Limited</u>". The cheque will be returned to the applicant by post if the application is unsucessful.

A processing fee of HKD 300 will be charged for any unsuccessful application, including incomplete application. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that they fulfil the eligibility criteria, and to make sure all required documentation and fees are submitted by the required date.

Higher Surgical Trainees are required to pay their registration fee annually within the first month of the year until they have completed their Higher Surgical Training.

- 4) The appointment to a hospital <u>must be certified</u> by the respective supervisor before the respective training period could be recognized and registered.
- 5) A registered trainee will receive a Guide to Surgical Training upon successful registration including the following documents:
 - Rules & Regulations for Higher Surgical Trainee
 - Syllabus / Curriculum
 - Eligibility for Fellowship Examinations
 - Eligibility for Examination Eligible Candidate / Fellowship
 - Guidelines on Workplace-Based Assessment for Higher Surgical Trainee
 - Guidance Notes for Research Requirements
 - Guidelines on Major Operation for Higher Surgical Trainee
 - Principles & Guidelines on Continuing Medical Education(CME) and Continuing Professional Development(CPD)
 - Mandatory Courses for Higher Surgical Trainee admitted from 1 July 2021 onwards
 - Half-yearly Assessment Documentation
 - Workplace-Based Assessment Forms
 - Training Plan
 - Index Operation Fulfillment Form
 - Logbook Order Form
 - Update of Personal Information
 - Policy on Annual Subscription
