4.	Certified true copy of CSHK Certificate of Completion of Research Requirement	
5.	Period of training experiences listed on the application form <u>must be verified by existing</u> <u>COS or supervisor with signature and hospital stamp</u> .	
6.	Supporting letter from Chief of Service/training supervisor certifying fulfilment of 42-month of training. (For applicants who will reach their required training period by 30 <sup>th</sup> June 2024).	
7.	Certified true copy of Certificates of <b>COMPLETION</b> of mandatory courses: ( <i>Please ensure the courses completed fulfil the specific course requirements listed on the Mandatory Courses for Plastic Surgery trainees</i> ):

9.	Two passport photographs with your name on the back of the photographs.	
10.	Annual Registration Fee of HST/EEC of the exam year and those in arrears are paid.	
11.	Fulfilled the presentation/publication requirements (For details of presentation/publication requirements, please refer to "PRESENTATION / PUBLICATION REQUIREMENTS" in "Rules & Regulations for Higher Surgical Trainee").	
12.	Sufficient postage otherwise the application will be treated incomplete application which will not be processed.	

Copies of letters and certificates will only be accepted if they have been verified as true copies by the Consultant or authorised hospital official and stamped with the hospital stamp. (The signature (name of verifier should be stated) and hospital stamp must be original) All stamps must be in English.

It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that they fulfil the eligibility criteria, and to make sure all required documentation and fee are submitted by the required date. Late application or incomplete application (including insufficient postage) will not be accepted. No allowance will be made for postal or other delays.

**Late applications or incomplete applications will be returned to the applicants.** Applications with all supporting documents **MUST reach** the College Secretariat <u>on or before the closing date</u> as stipulated in the examination calendar. Application received will be acknowledged by email.
