Professor Dinesh Bhugra was born in India and received his medical education in Armed Forces Medical College at Poona University in India. He then received psychiatric training in India and subsequently moved to work in the UK. He subsequently became a Professor of Mental Health and Diversity at the Institute of Psychiatry at King's College, London. In 2008, he was elected as the President of Royal College of Psychiatrists, the first President coming from an ethnic minority and immigrant background. After stepping down as the President of the College in 2011, he moved on to become the President-Elect (2011-2014) and President (2014-2017) of the World Psychiatric Association which represents 138 national member societies representing over 115 countries and 200,000 psychiatrists around the Globe. During his terms as the President of the Royal College and World Psychiatric Association, he has led many global initiatives to improve mental health in different parts of the world. He has rich experience in working with and influencing politicians, policy makers, philanthropists, other health and social sectors, as well as ethnic and sexual minority groups. In 2018, he became the President-Elect of the British Medical Association, the professional association and registered trade union representing 160,000 medical doctors in the United Kingdom. In 2012, he received the CBE in the 2012 New Years' Honours in the UK. Prof Bhugra is a prolific writer and has written over 30 books, 90 book chapters, 100 editorials, and over 180 peer-reviewed articles.
