7.	 Certified true copy of Certificate of COMPLETION of mandatory courses: Advanced Trauma Life Support Course (ATLS) (A proof of successful pass on the course is required) Paediatric Advanced Life Support Course Research Training Workshop

(The signature (name of verifier should be stated) and hospital stamp must be original) All stamps must be in English.

It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that they fulfil the eligibility criteria, and to make sure all required documentation and fee are submitted by the required date. Late application or incomplete application (including insufficient postage) will not be accepted. No allowance will be made for postal or other delays.

Late applications or incomplete applications will be returned to the applicants. Applications with all supporting documents MUST reach the College Secretariat on or before the closing date as stipulated in the examination calendar. Application received will be acknowledged by email.

Certified true copy of certificate is required only for the **FIRST ATTEMPT** at Fellowship Examination.
